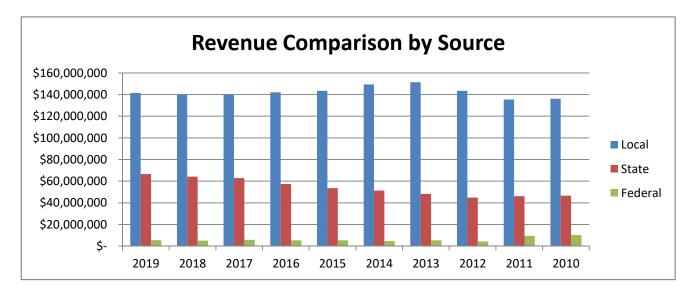

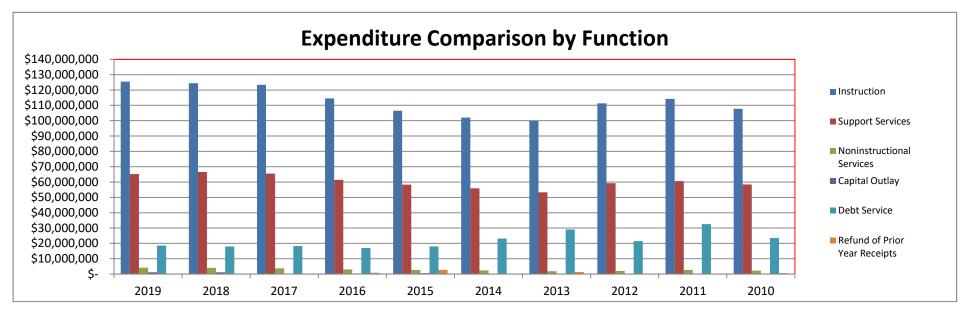

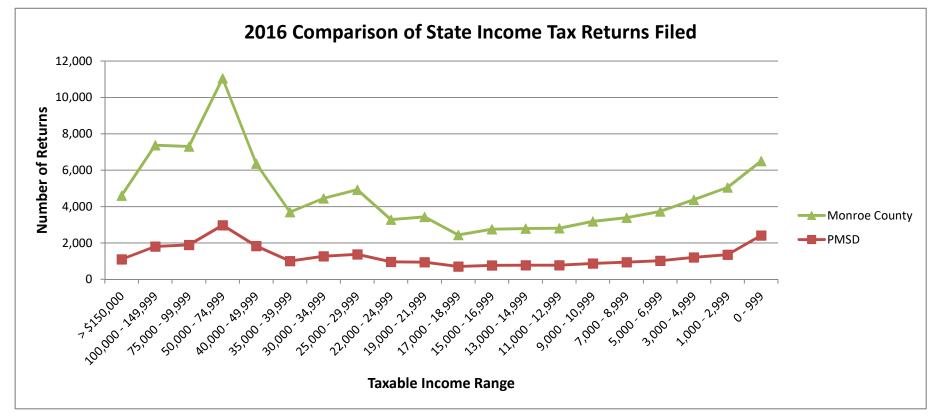

Last ten calendar years ending December 31,

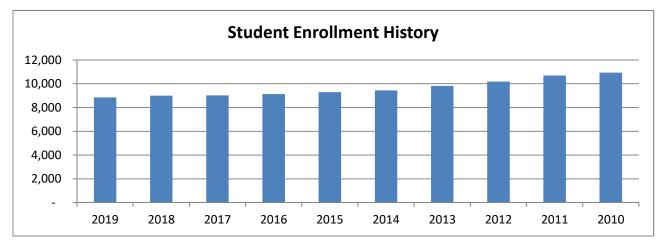
