Seniors graduating in June, 2028 will need 22 total credits to graduate. Included within these 22 credits are: 4 credits of English, 3 credits of Social Studies, 4 credits of Math, 3 credits of Science, 2 credits of Physical Education & Health, and a minimum of 6 elective credits (**completion of a Computer Science course is required**). In some instances, it is possible to substitute an AP course for a core requirement. Talk with your counselor if this is something you'd like to pursue.

Please use the lists below to select your courses. You will have room in your schedule for six (6) credits: four required or core courses and two electives. The electives may be full or half-year as long as they total two (2) full credits. Your core courses are already entered into the system. You can review them when scheduling with your counselor.
