Seniors graduating in June, 2025 will need 22 total credits to graduate. Included within these 22 credits are: 4 credits of English, 3 credits of Social Studies, 4 credits of Math, 3 credits of Science, 2 credits of Physical Education & Health, and 6 elective credits. In some instances, it is possible to substitute an AP course for a core requirement. Talk with your counselor if this is something you'd like to pursue.

The electives may be full or half-year as long as they total two (2) full credits. Your core courses are already entered into the system. You can review them when scheduling with your counselor.
