

2017 Hall of Fame Members: Megan Bossuyt, John Nauman, Nathan Reddicks, Cheri Neff-Prior and Neil Unternahrer

Megan Bossuyt: Field Hockey, Basketball, Track

Megan was a 4-year varsity player for the Pocono Mountain field hockey team, helping lead the 1991-92 squad to the District Final and State tournament. She served as team captain her senior year, earned First Team All-League honors and was named to the Centennial League All-Star Team, where she was awarded MVP of game.

Bossuyt was also a 3-year varsity player and 2 year starter for the record setting Cardinal basketball team. Her defensive play helped the team earn Centennial League Champions (1992, 1993), District 11 AAAA Runner Up (1993), Easton Tournament Champions (1993) and best record in school history 26-7 (1993). Megan was named to the 1992-1993 LARC (Lehigh Association of Rehabilitation Centers) All-Star Basketball Team.

Bossuyt ran track her freshman and sophomore years and was part of two record setting relay teams during the 1989-1990 season: (51.5) as a member of the 400-relay team and (4:12.5) as a member of the 1600 relay team.

John Nauman: Football, Wrestling, Baseball

John started the fourth game of his freshman football season and finished his career with 36 consecutive starts. He never came out of a game his last 3 seasons. In 1968, he received the MVP trophy for football.

In wrestling, John earned 2 letters. He won the 180 lb. Lehigh-Northampton League Championship. After the first 10 years of PMHS athletics, John was voted to the Wrestling Dream Team at 180 lb.

John earned 3 letters in baseball. He was on the 1967 baseball team that won the Lehigh-Northampton League Championship and played in the District 11 playoff. John's senior year, he was co-captain of football, wrestling and baseball. He also was PMHS Scholar Athlete.

In 1974, John started coaching football and baseball. He helped PMHS baseball team become League Champs, Regional Champs, and win a state playoff game in 1979.

Nathan Reddicks: Football, Wrestling

Nathan was a standout on both offense and defense and earned 2 varsity letters in football. He was the player of the year his senior year for the football team.

In wrestling, Nathan earned 4 varsity letters and was the league tournament champion at 138 lbs his sophomore year. Nathan won the outstanding wrestler award his senior year and held the fast pin record (12 seconds).

Cheri Neff-Prior: Field Hockey, Track

Cheri was a 3-year letterman on the field hockey team, a 2-time MVP and captain her senior year. She was a first team all-Conference player her sophomore through senior years. She led the team in scoring in her junior and senior year as well as assists in her senior year.

In track, Cheri was a 4-year letterman and captain her senior year. She set a League record for the 1600 M event (5:28) and held the school record for the 1600 M and 3200 M events. She won the gold medal in the league meet her sophomore year in the 1600 M event. Cheri also placed 1st in a statewide freshman meet in the 400 M, 1600 M, and 1600 M relay races.

Neil Unternahrer: Soccer, Tennis

Neil Unternahrer was a four-year varsity letter winner in soccer. In soccer, he scored 64 career goals and had 36 career assists from 1999 to 2002. He received league honorable mention for soccer in 1999, 2nd team all MVC in 2000 and 2001 and was named 1st team all MVC in 2002. In 2002, Neil was named to the Pocono Record All Area Soccer Team.

Neil was also a four year varsity tennis singles player.Neil was a member of Pocono Mountain's MVC Team Championship in 2003.
