Board works to provide tax relief

Pocono Mountain School District residents who are eligible for the PA Property Tax Rebate Program can expect to see the rebate they receive from the school district increased thanks to a resolution passed by the Board of Education on April 20, 2016.

With this resolution, qualifying property owners will now receive their state rebate and an additional amount equal to 200 percent of the state rebate from the school district.
