Dear AP World History: Modern Student:

Congratulations on your enrollment in the AP World History: Modern course. Advanced Placement history classes are designed to be more rigorous and challenging than the standard required history classes. It is important for students and parents to know that these courses will require more complex reading and writing assignments throughout the school year, as well as summer reading assignments with a specific writing component. Students who have enrolled in AP World History will be required to read *A Little History of the World* written by E.H. Gombrich.
