Mr. Vican currently serves as the President Judge, Court of Common Pleas, Monroe Country.

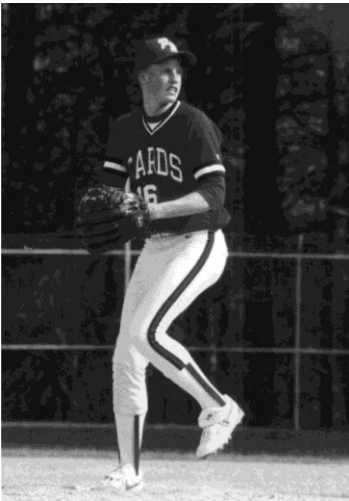
Jim Cadue, Class of 1967

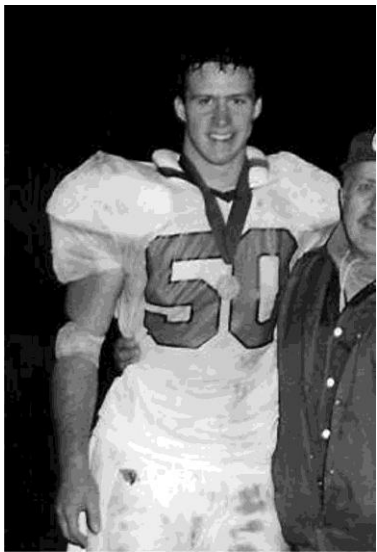
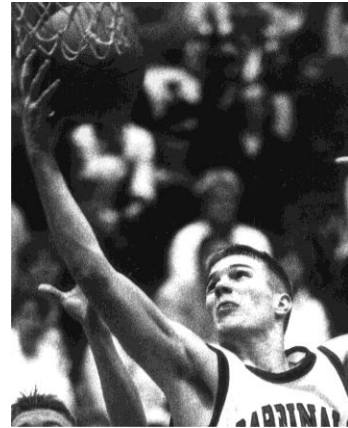
Bill Smith, Class of 1991
