


Kevin Hall

In Basketball, earned 4 letters, she has 1363 career point and was 1st team her junior and senior years. 
James Feimster

He helped lead the team to back-to-back Mountain Division Championships. James also lettered in Basketball, Baseball, and Track and Field.



Amber Wittel

Amber (DeYoung) Wittel was a 3 year lettermen for both the Field Hockey and Track and Field teams. Her accomplishments on the field hockey team included Centennial League Champion, All-League Honorable Mention, MVP Offensive Player and she played in the senior All-State Game. She was the team captain as well as leading scorer. Amber also played in the Keystone State Games and was selected for the AAU Junior Olympics. In Track and Field Amber was 2nd in the Centennial League 400m relay, 1st in the Centennial League 1600m relay during her senior year, and during her junior year she placed 3rd in the District XI 400m, 3rd in the District XI 1600m relay, 1st in the Centennial League 1600m and 3200M relays.



Pete Treible

Pete was the Honorable Mention Centennial League Split End and Defensive Back for Football in his junior year. During his senior year, Pete was 2nd team Centennial League Running Back, 3rd team All-Area Running Back. In his junior year, Pete held the 100m school record with a time of 10.8 seconds, the 200m School, League and District XI record with a time of 22.5 seconds, the 1600m Relay League meet record with a time of 3:26.48 seconds, the 400m relay District XI record with a time of 44.38 seconds. Pete was a League Champion in the 200m, 400m relay and 1600m relay. A District XI Champion in the 100m, 200m, and 400m relay and placed 5th at the PIAA State meet in the 100m. In his

senior year ,Pete set the 200m School, League and District XI record with a time of 22.2 seconds. He was a League champion in the 100m, 200m and 400m relay, a District XI champion in the 100m, 200m and PIAA State Track meet-9th place in the 100m.
