## Prom 2024: The Stuff You Need To know!

Prom will be held on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>May 11</u>, <u>2024 at The Americus Hotel in Allentown</u>. Prom Packets will be distributed sometime in January with all of the information that you need to know, including price and payment dates. Payments are typically accepted in March and April.

**BEHAVIOR:** Any student who accumulates 11 or more days of <u>ISS and/or</u> OSS for the 2023-24 school year will NOT be eligible to attend Prom. Students who have 1-10 days of ISS/OSS will be placed under administrative review, meaning that school administrators will decide if you are eligible to attend Prom. <u>If you are suspended for a drug or weapons violation of any kind, you will NOT be able to attend Prom.</u>

ATTENDANCE: Attendance will be monitored as per school district policy. Students who exceed G days of unexcused/unlawful absences and/or unexcused tardies or 18 days of absences and/or tardies overall (excused and unexcused) may not be eligible to attend Prom. Please make sure all attendance notes are turned in within three days of your absence throughout the school year.

**DRESS CODE:** Please be aware that there is a strict dress code for Prom attire. Please use common sense when choosing a Prom dress, especially when considering length, body type and fit. Any questions should be directed to Ms. Paul or Mrs. Fladger BEFORE a dress is purchased. More specific information will be given during Prom Certification Classes.

ACADEMICS: Students must be passing all classes and be on track with all credit recovery courses they are taking in order to attend Prom.

FOOD/BEVERAGE: All food and beverages at the Pre-Prom Reception and Prom will be provided by the WHS Student Council. Students and guests are NOT permitted to bring food and beverages to the Pre-Prom Reception or Prom.

PROM CERTIFICATION CLASSES: ALL Seniors MUST attend one Prom Certification Class, taught by Ms. Paul and Mr. McGovern, in order to attend Prom. Classes will be held starting in January or February. You will attend Prom Certification Class with your English class. Topics will include guest rules, dress code, appropriate dancing and much more!

**PROM GUESTS:** WHS Seniors in good standing are eligible to bring ONE guest to Prom. Guests must fit in to one of the following categories:

- A. Current WHS Senior in good standing
- B. Current WHS Junior in good standing
- C. Current WHS Sophomore in good standing
- D. Current WHS Freshman in good standing
- E. **PMSD** Graduate, **under the age of 21** (Graduation year must be provided.)
- F. Current <u>HIGH SCHOOL</u> student, <u>under the age of</u> **21** (Must provide a letter on school letterhead signed by a school administrator stating that the student is in good standing. Must be turned in by the MARCH payment date.)
