Dear Parents/Guardians and Staff,

On Friday, January 29, 2021, Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 was notified of a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19) at Pocono West High School. The person was last in the building on Monday, January 25, 2021.

School leadership, in conjunction with local public health officials, had determined that the classroom that had been affected will be **engaging in virtual learning beginning Monday**, **February 1, 2021**. A tentative return date of **in-person instruction will be on Tuesday**, **February 9, 2021**. The classrooms and spaces used by the individual have been closed off, cleaned and disinfected according to CDC guidelines.

Staff members and students who may have come into close contact (any individual within 6 feet of an infected individual for at least 15 minutes) with the individual will be directly contacted by their local health department and/or and/or staff of the Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 with instructions to self-quarantine.

Parents and students are encouraged to do the following to help prevent the spread of illness at home and in school:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Wash your hands frequently.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your mouth and nose with the inside of your elbow when you cough and sneeze.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Practice social distancing and wear a mask.
