Only Pocono Mountain West High School Seniors may attend. Please read over this sheet for important information. Please also understand that we do not know every piece of information about Prom yet. We are working with ever-changing guidelines and information and are striving to create a memorable and safe Prom for the Class of 2021. As we get more information and go further in our planning, we will share information with you. We ask for your patience and cooperation to make this a great Prom for your class!

Attendance and Academic Requirements

In order to attend Prom, you must meet the following guidelines:

- ☐ Seniors may not exceed 10 days of unexcused absences or 18 days of absence overall for the 2020-21 school year.
- ☐ Seniors must be passing all of their classes.

Dress Code

Prom is a formal event and seniors are expected to dress accordingly. When purchasing a Prom dress, please remember that dresses cannot be extremely short, extremely low cut or have high slits. We also do not allow two-piece dresses.

Food and Beverage

Students may NOT bring their own food and beverages to the Prom. For safety reasons, we will not be serving food at Prom, though water will be available. We will be providing some small treats to take home and enjoy.

Safety Measures

It is very important that we have a SAFE Prom. All Seniors in attendance MUST wear a mask at all times. It is also expected that Seniors maintain a safe distance from each other and do not congregate in large groups.

Sign-up dates

In order to attend Prom, you must sign up using a Google Form that will be emailed to you. Sign up dates will be April 6-16. We cannot accept late sign-ups because everything will be planned around the number of students attending. There will not be a cost for Prom this year.

Prom Information Meetings

In late April or early May, we will hold a Zoom meeting for all seniors who will be attending Prom. This will be offered on several dates at several times. If you would like to attend Prom on May 22, you MUST attend one of these meetings. Exact dates will be sent out after April 16. If you do not attend one of these meetings, you will not be able to attend Prom.
