\*This is not a dress down. The shirt can be worn over Standardized Dress attire\*

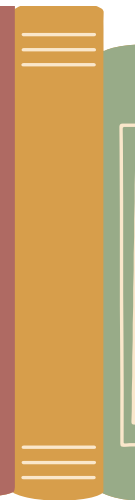
Wear tie-dye today to show off your love for books! Sit back, relax, and enjoy some time reading! Check out our library for some of your favorite genres or even books on relaxation.
