The Monroe County Local Children's Roundtable will host its sixth annual Community Night on May 3, 2022, from 6:00 to 8:15 p.m., at the Monroe Campus of Northampton Community College. We invite you, your families, and members of your church, faith-based community, organization, department, association, municipality, or group to join us for this amazing event. Our goal is to connect as many people to services as possible . . . connect as many volunteers to programs as possible . . . and bring together as many residents as possible to learn, share, network, and have fun as a community! We are one community, and, as this year's theme reinforces, we are "In this Together!"

Community Night is held in May, because it pairs nicely with Mental Health Awareness Month and Foster Care Awareness Month, which are also observed in May. Community Night is free and open to all. The event will provide information and resources from more than 90 agencies and organizations to families and their children on a variety of topics, including: substance use disorder, mental health, physical health, nutrition, child welfare, education for adults and children, youth programs, our schools and school districts, and support services available to all. There will be interactive areas, therapy dogs, and really neat exhibits and programs for kids. A student art contest is underway! All artwork received will be prominently displayed and winners will be announced at Community Night. The top three entries in both the junior and senior divisions will receive \$50, \$75 or \$100 gift cards. In addition to the student art exhibit, student musicians will entertain us. All four Monroe County school districts and MCTI will be represented! The Bookmobile, the Bloodmobile, and the smokehouse will be on hand. Also, there will be a scavenger hunt with great prizes!

Beginning at approximately 3:45 p.m., there will be a student-focused interactive musical program performed by Flintface. Flintface concerts and music include strong, positive messages on resiliency, suicide prevention and mental health awareness for our youth. This message is even more relevant and important to our students this year as we try to recover as a community from the COVID-19 pandemic's impact on our schools.

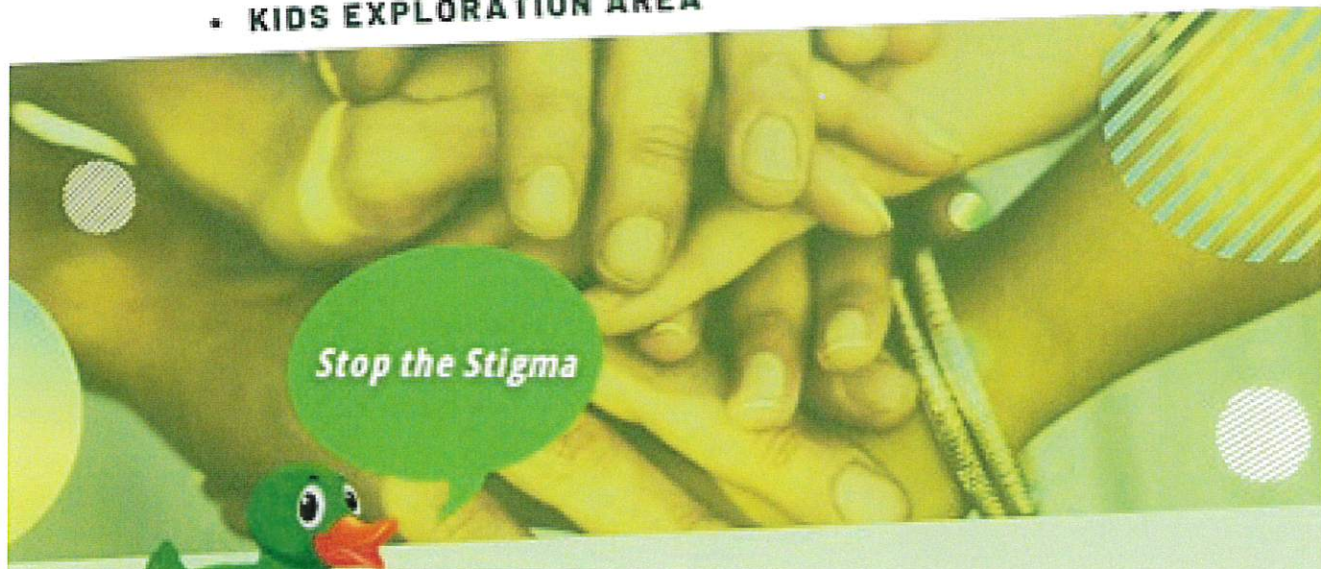
