

College Planning Timetable

Spring of Junior year:

-Take the SAT or the ACT
-Begin your college search (internet, library, Guidance office)
-Begin to research Scholarship Opportunities (internet, library)

Summer between Junior and Senior year:

-Schedule college campus visits (tour the campus and meet with the Financial Aid Officer and Admissions staff)
-You can register for an “Open House” on the college’s website, or make an appointment by calling the college admissions office.

Fall of Senior year:

-Attend “Financial Aid Night” / complete FAFSA (www.fafsa.gov)
-Complete the State aid form (for PA: www.pheaa.org)
-Complete your college applications
-Take SAT or ACT again, if you wish
-Attend College Fairs if you wish
-Continue to research scholarship opportunities (Internet, Library, “Scholarship File” in the Guidance office)

January / February of Senior year:

-Check the “Scholarship Box” in the Guidance office every 2 weeks. Apply for Scholarships you qualify for.
-Follow-up with your Counselor if you have further questions
